



Windows 2000 DST 2007 Changes

Download the program above and run (tzedit.exe) - by default, the current time zone is already highlighted for you, so go ahead and click "Edit"

Now, enter the new date settings in DST portion of the time zone:

Starts 2nd Sunday of March at 2:00 AM

Ends 1st Sunday of November at 2:00 AM

That should be the only change you need to make - Click "OK", then "Close".

In order to make the computer apply the changes your must **reboot** your computer.

These settings need to be changed on all computers that are running Windows 2000.

Windows XP DST 2007 Changes

Microsoft sent out system updates to fix this issue. If your computers are not connected to the internet you can download the patch at the following link:
